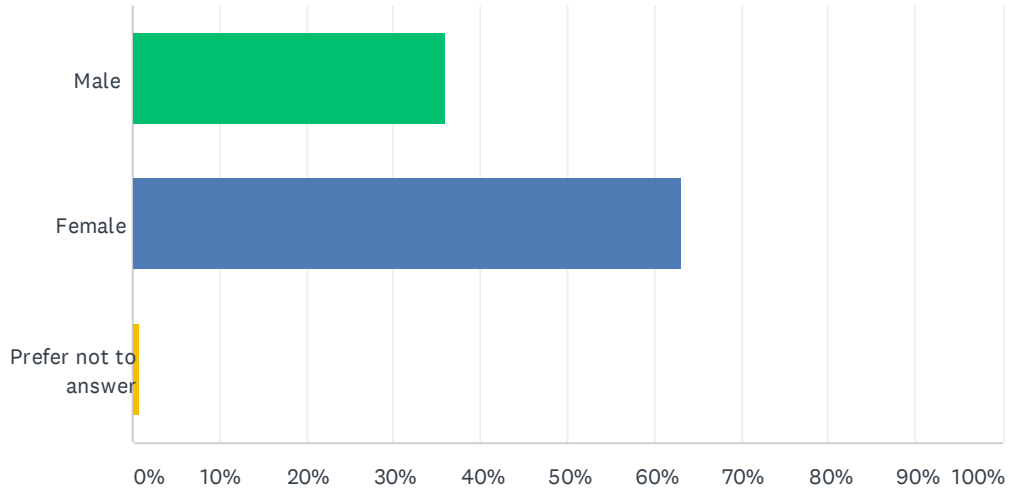

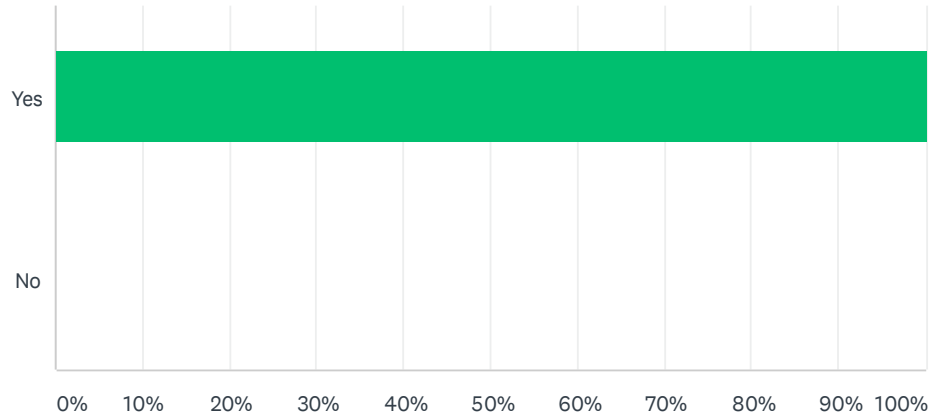

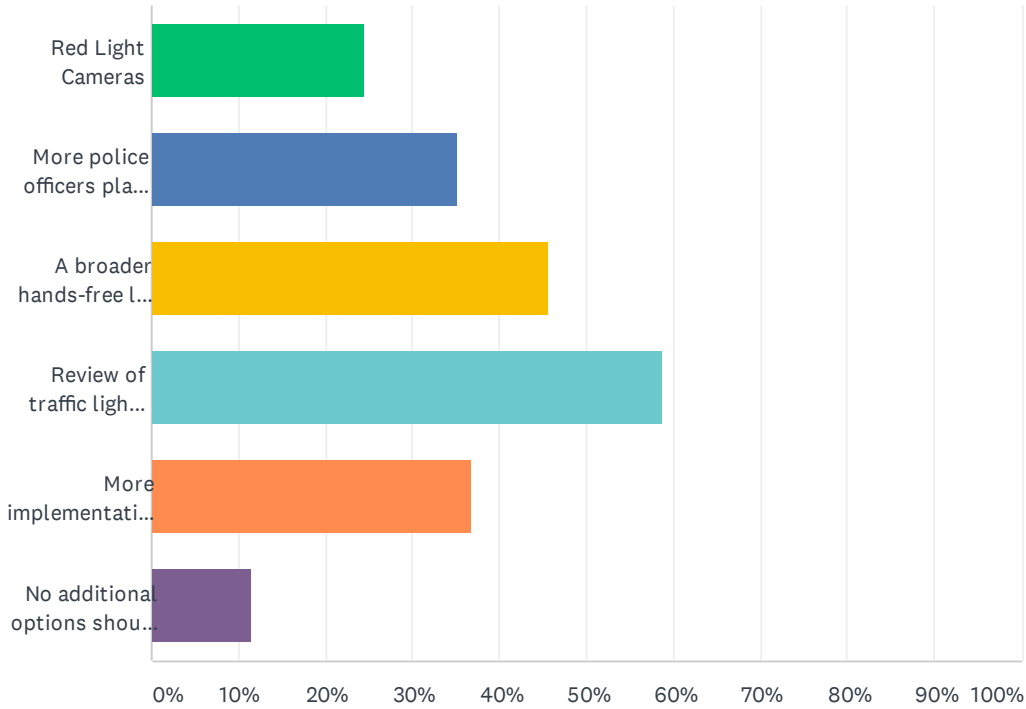

Q4 What would you be in favor of enforcing/implementing to help make our roads safer? Choose all you would be in favor of.

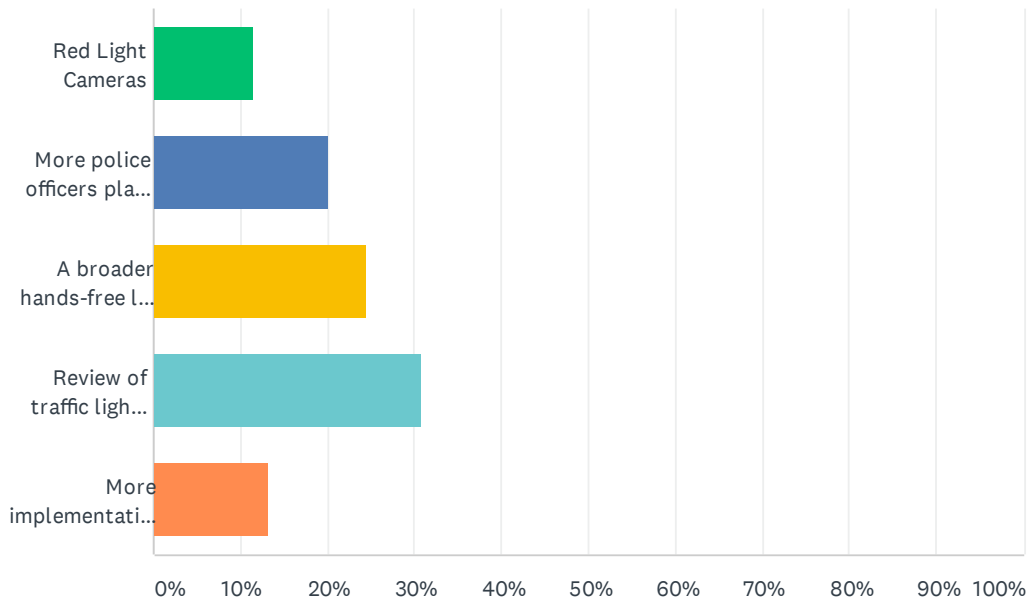

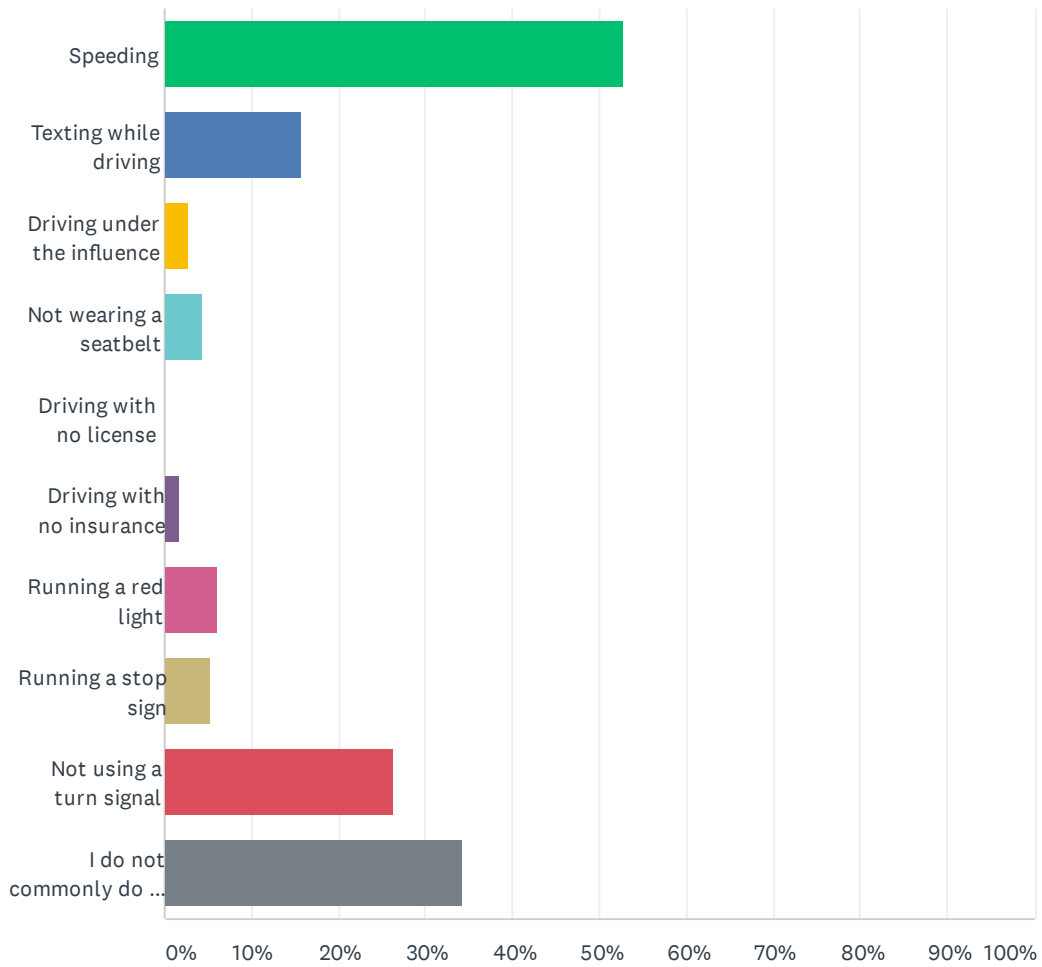

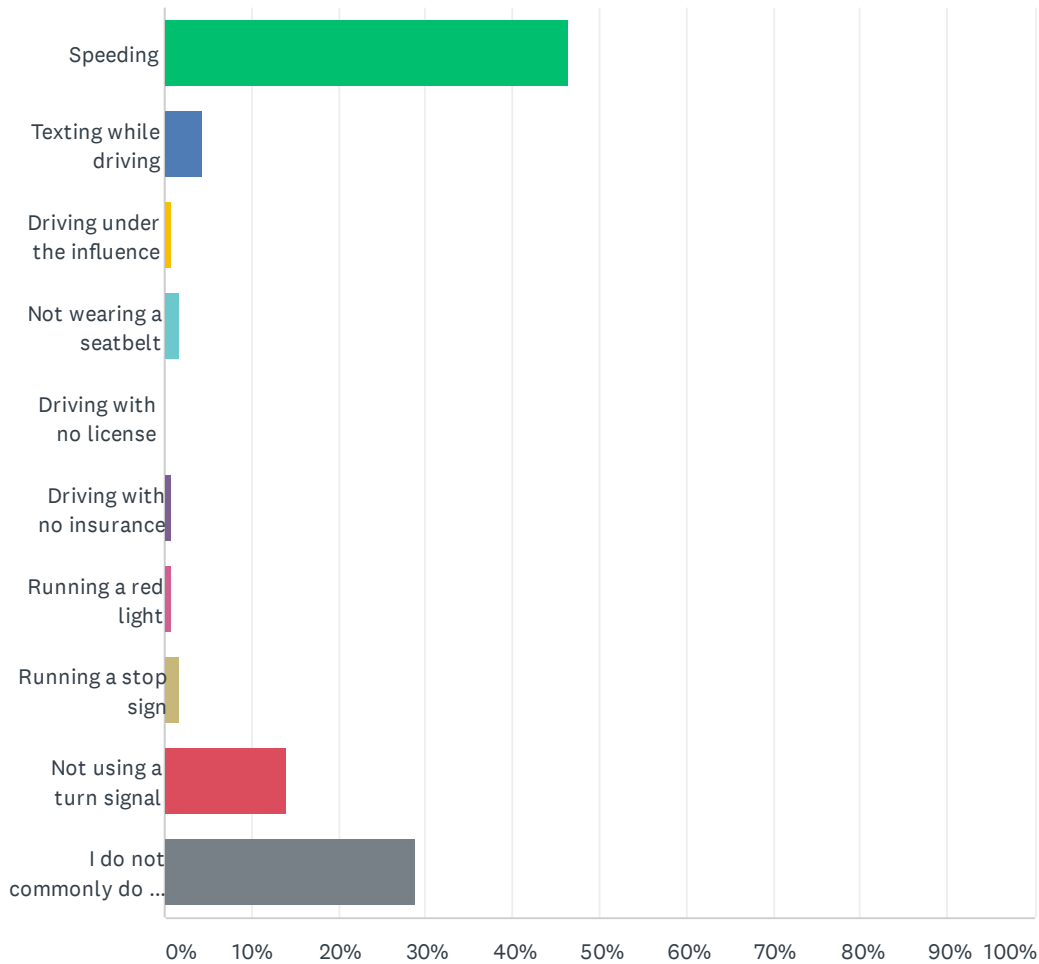

Q7 Which road rule do you break most often? Choose only one.

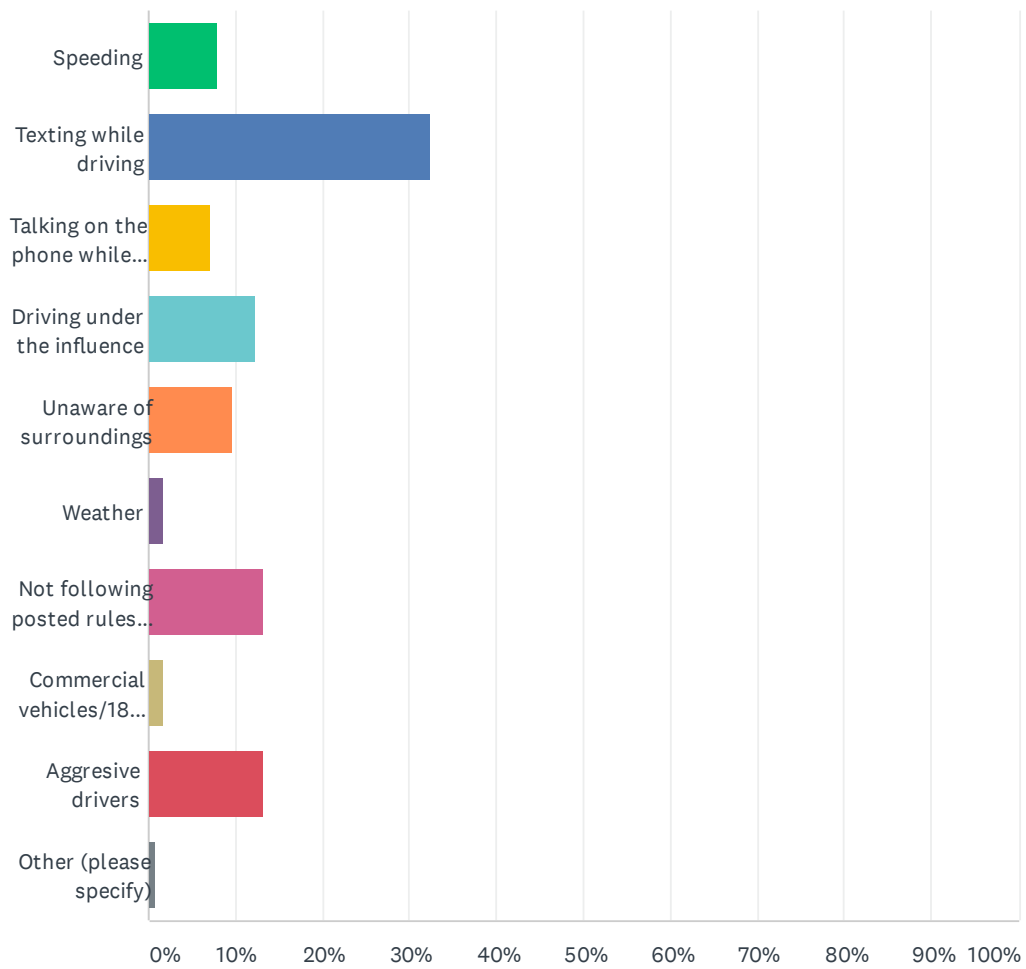

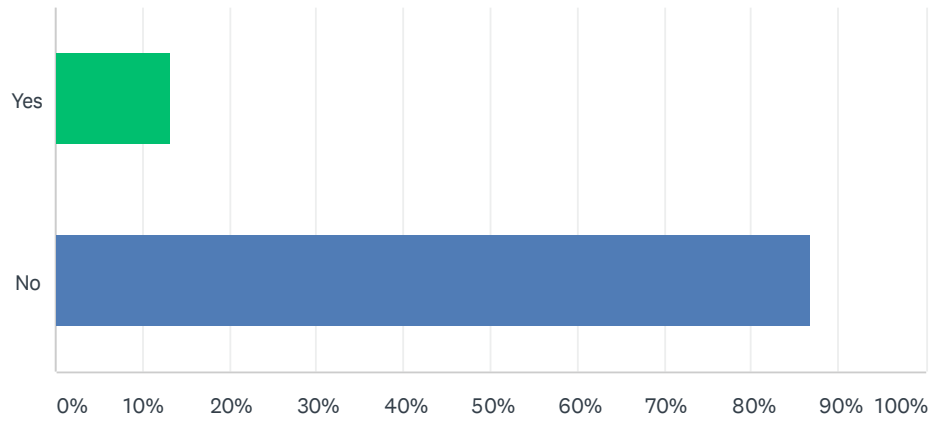

Q9 Have you been in an accident in the last year?

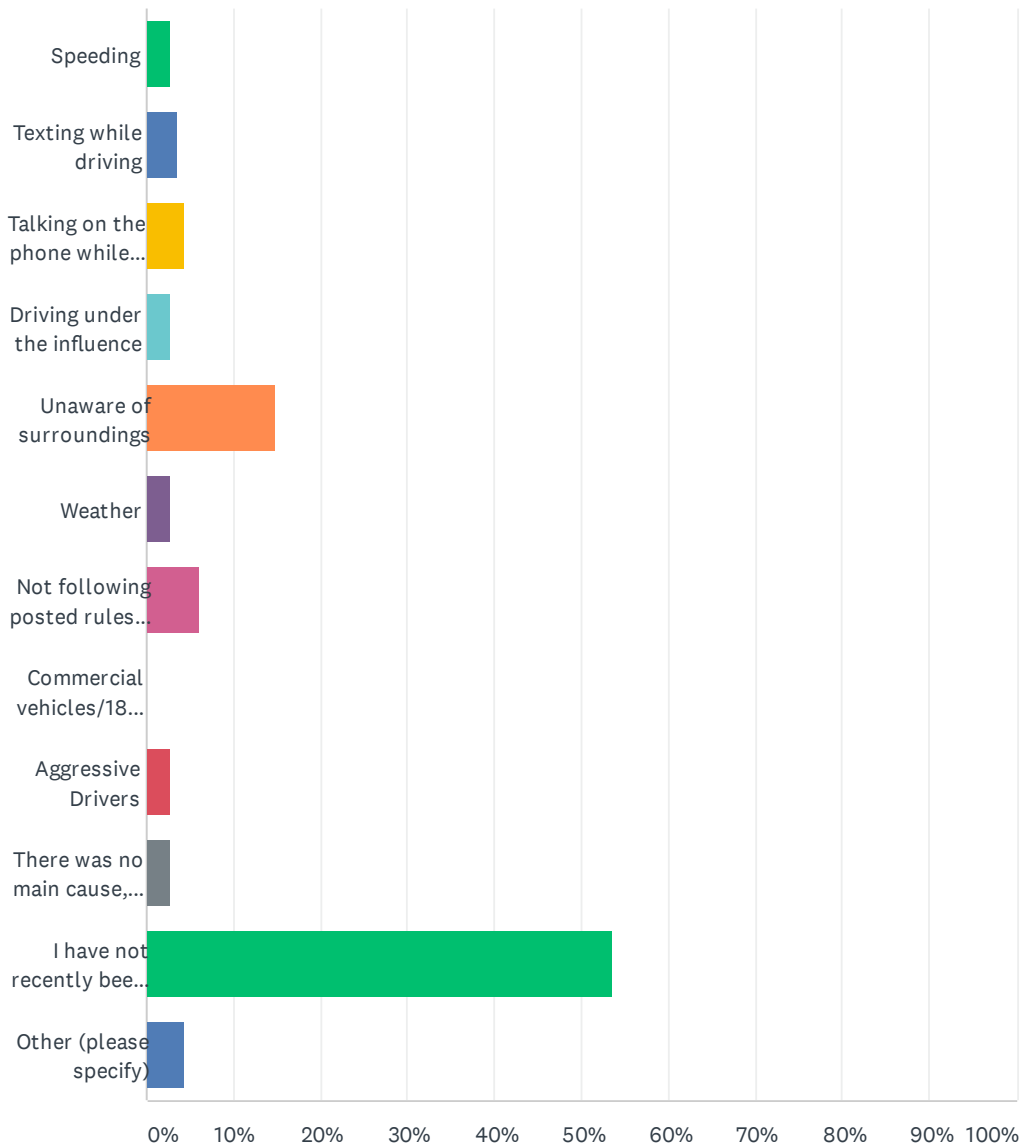

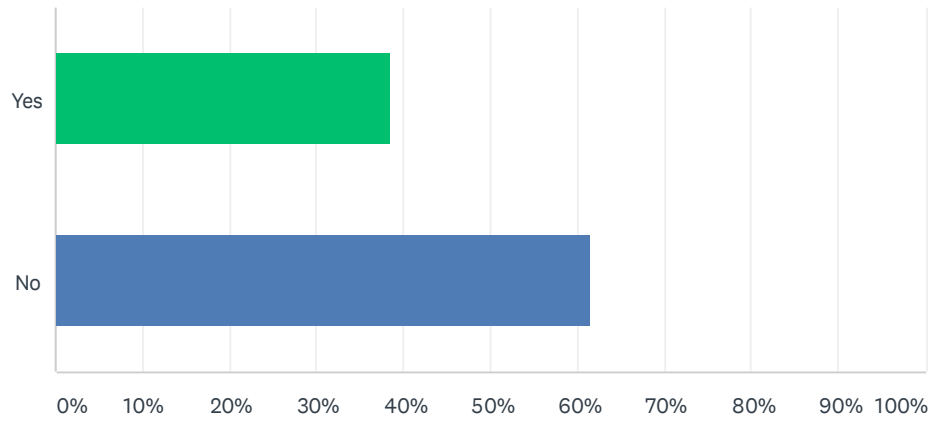

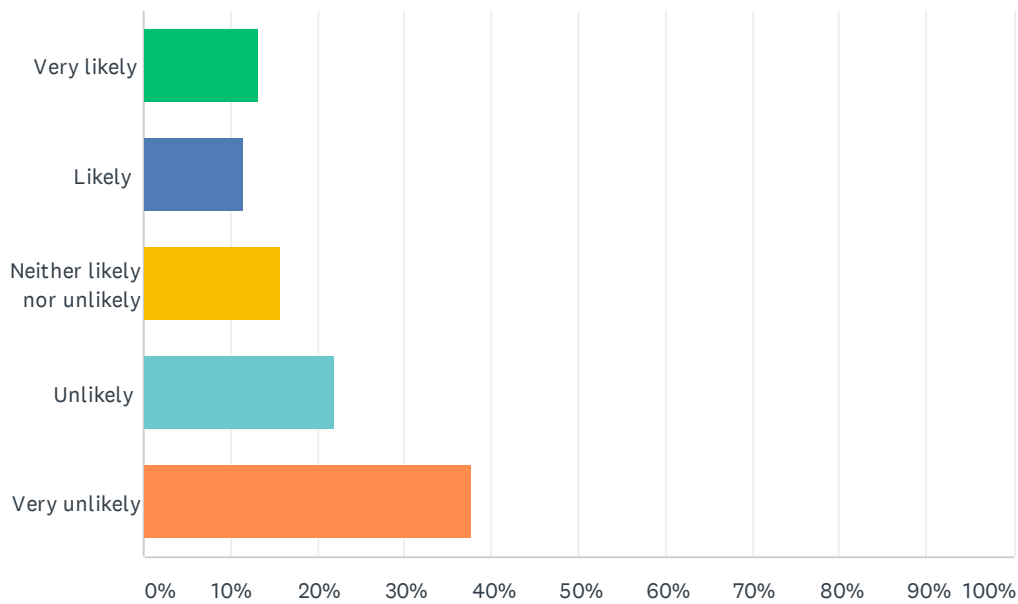

Q12 How likely are you to purchase a self-driving car, once the technology is fully developed?

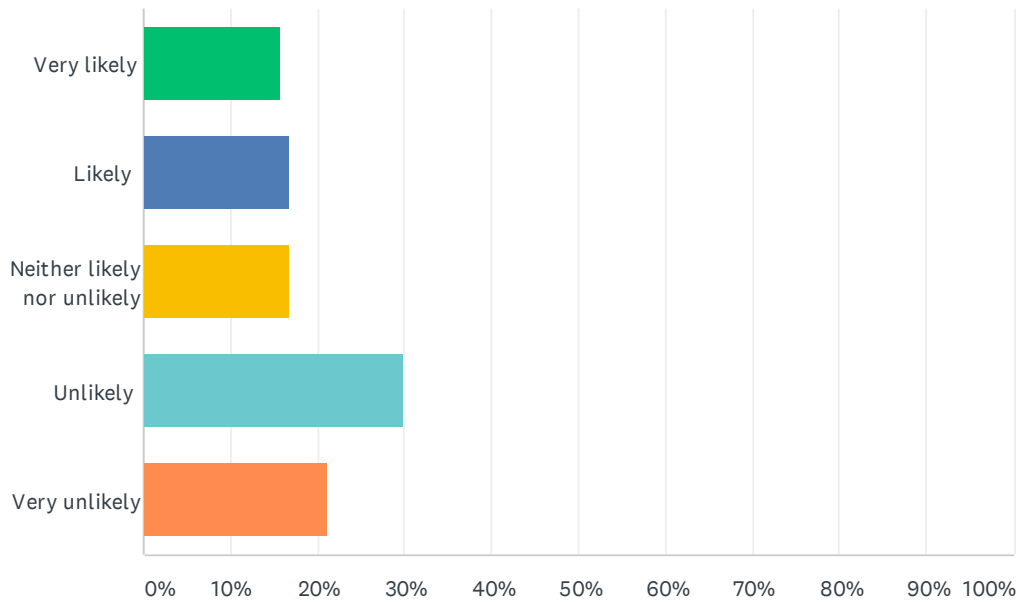

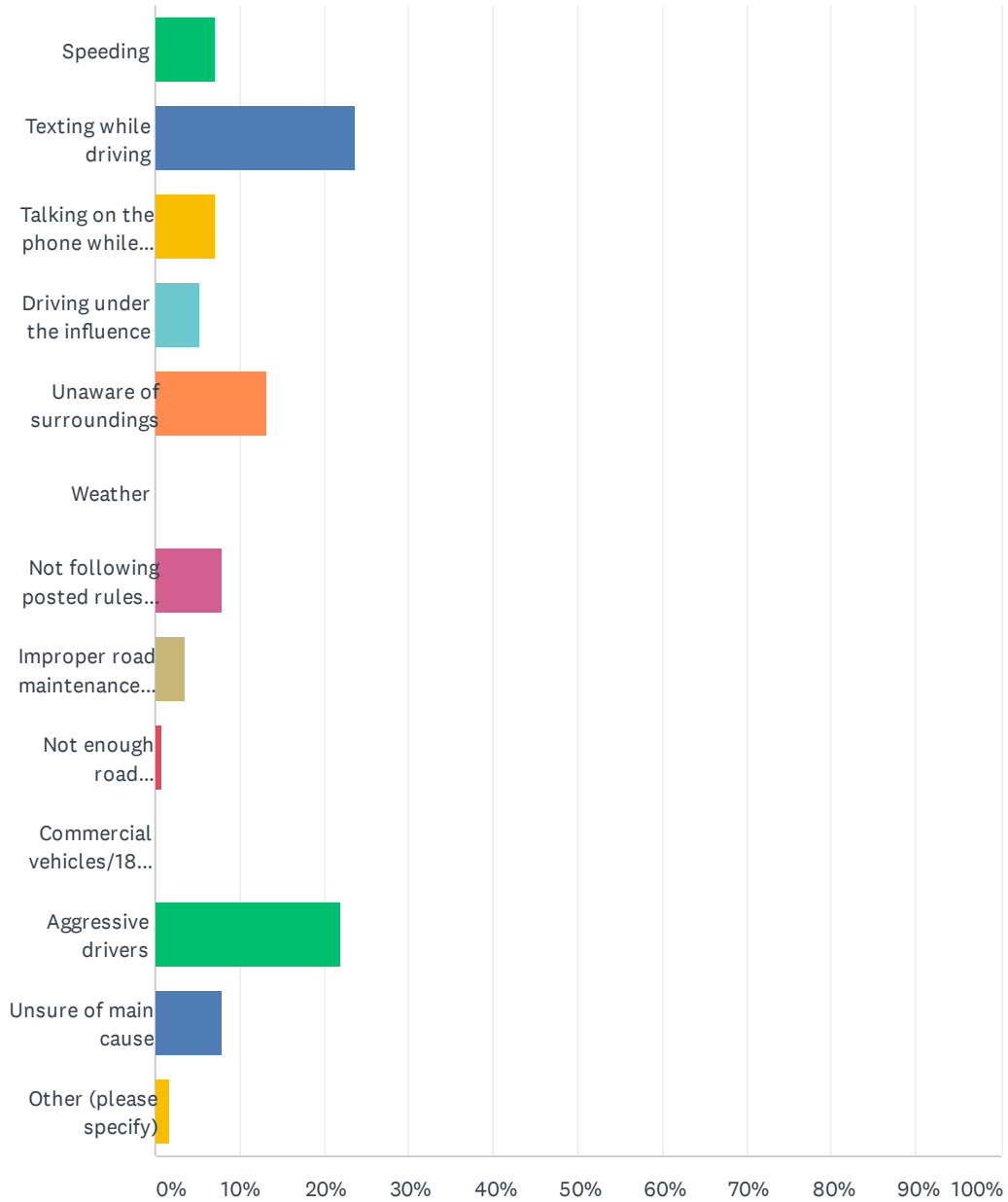
